

APPLICATION FOR RECEIVING A LETTER IN COLORGUARD

It is an honor to receive a Letter for your participation in colorguard. A Letter signifies that you have gone “above and beyond” the requirements of the activity. For that reason, there will be students who show incredible talent in colorguard and do not receive a Letter. A Letter shows that you have put in *extra* time and effort.

There are two parts to qualifying for a Letter. There is the Basic Requirements section and the Points section. Students must meet all of the requirement from the Basic Requirements list below in order to qualify for the Points section of this application.

STEP ONE: BASIC REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for a Letter, students must first satisfy ALL of the below requirements:

Check all that apply:

- _____ Perform in colorguard for 3 seasons (Fall, Winter, Spring)
- _____ Participate in a Fall guard, Winter guard, and Spring Guard.
- _____ Have no more than ONE excused absence from a rehearsal in each of the seasons.
- _____ Participate in ALL competitions and performances with NO excused or unexcused absences.
- _____ Have no outstanding debt to the Evergreen Band and Guard Boosters or Evergreen High School.
- _____ Have not received a letter in previous years.

STEP TWO: POINTS REQUIREMENTS

After meeting the above requirements, all students must earn 100 points from the list of activities below to qualify for a band letter. Points will accumulate from year to year as long as the requirements above are maintained in all of the years from which you draw points. To be awarded points for an activity, the student must have NO unexcused absences from a rehearsal for that activity, missed no more than one rehearsal for any reason, and missed NO performances for that activity for any reason.

_____ 30	Participate in Winter Colorguard.
_____ 10	Parade Colorguard (includes extra rehearsals and all parades).
_____ 10	Participate in a summer colorguard camp approved by the colorguard caption head.
_____ 5	Perform primarily on rifle or sabre.
_____	Serve on committees, work on fundraiser that is not for student’s personal account, and other projects approved by Mr. Kuske. Please explain these below or on the back side of this sheet.
