



EHS Band and Colorguard Boosters 2008 Holiday Gift Wrapping at Borders

What: Wrap gifts at Borders located at 811 SE 160th Ave.
When: Tuesday December 2, Tuesday December 9, and Thursday December 11
Amount: Tips earned during all 3 days combined are evenly divided amongst student accounts based on hours worked

How it works:

1. You work a shift at Borders wrapping presents. We must have at least 1 adult per shift. Please, only adults and students who are able to wrap gift items neatly and professionally should sign up!
2. We are providing this service at no charge to Borders or their customers. Instead, customers are encouraged to tip for the service; we will provide a tip jar. Tips are then combined for all days worked and divided up amongst student accounts based on hours worked.
3. Open shifts are posted on the web. Due to the limited number of shifts available, there is a limit of 1 shift per student account at this time. Any open shifts remaining as of 1 week before the day of the event will be available on a first come first serve basis.
4. Arrive on time! If you are late: Call Colleen ASAP! Keep her # with you so we don't assume you are not coming, you may forfeit your shift if we have found coverage. Depending on situation, you may not be allowed to participate in all future shift work fundraisers.
5. NO SHOW: If you are a no show, you may not be allowed to participate in future shift work fundraisers.
6. Cancellation of shift: call Colleen @ 360-713-7435. You must give 24 notice. If you give less than 24 hour notice and have a replacement, there will be no penalty. If you give less than 24 hour notice and we have to find a replacement for you, then this will be considered a no show.
7. Leaving from Fundraiser: You will be dismissed by the adult on duty when your replacement worker is up to speed.
8. A SIGN IN AND OUT book will be on site. This is the only way we know you came and stayed whole shift. Have the adult on duty sign if you were asked to stay longer.
9. If you are asked to leave for acting improperly: you forfeit hours worked and money earned & may not be allowed to participate in all future shift work fundraisers (including fireworks). Your actions could jeopardize our future participation in this fundraiser.
10. Dress Code: (not mandatory, just makes it more fun!!) Be Evergreen Proud while you are at any fundraiser!
 - a. Wear a past Marching season Shirt or
 - b. Beads- Green & Gold
 - c. Wear a dark green shirt or
 - d. Wear a Yellow Shirt or...
 - e. Wear both! Be creative!
